FORWARD Biobank

Our Biobank

FORWARD PROVIDES ACCESS TO, storage for, and analysis of biological samples. Current samples can be used to address specific research questions, or additional samples can be obtained from FORWARD participants. Samples have been collected on various diagnoses including: rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis, lupus, ankylosing spondylitis, fibromyalgia, osteoarthritis, and others.

TYPES OF SAMPLES FOR EACH PATIENT

- + Whole blood (DNA stabilized)
- + Whole blood (RNA stabilized)
- + Serum
- + EDTA Plasma
- + Cryopreserved white blood cells

BIOMARKERS ASSESSED FOR EACH PATIENT

- + CRP

Research Services



Safety Studies

LARGE NUMBERS OF PATIENTS with long term follow-up in this longitudinal population-based registry make the data ideal for safety studies. Reported outcomes of interest including, but not limited to, malignancies and hospitalizations are confirmed and validated with medical records. Additional data collection, including specialized questionnaires, sub-studies, and sample collection, is possible.



Patient Reported Outcomes

EXTENSIVE PATIENT REPORTED MEASURES are collected in this registry, and piloting and validation of new measures is possible as well.



Patient Preference

UNIQUE AND FOCUSED TOOLS used to collect a patient's preferences regarding social factors, economic factors, healthcare utilization, and medication formulation allow FORWARD to answer questions about real-life circumstances.



Effectiveness and Health Economic Analyses GIVEN THE HEALTHCARE UTILIZATION, OUTCOMES, AND ECONOMIC DATA collected in the patient questionnaire, FORWARD has the ability to perform sophisticated effectiveness and economic analyses.



Qualitative Research and Mixed Methods

FORWARD IS TAKING ONE STEP FURTHER to highlight the voice of patients with rheumatic diseases. We offer researchers and pharmaceutical companies the opportunity to explore how patients think and feel about their disease and treatments in the context of their lives.



Specialized Studies

FORWARD WELCOMES THE OPPORTUNITY to collaborate on innovative study designs and collection tools. Some possible areas of focus include medication adherence, biobank and genetic studies, and building a larger cohort for a population of interest.

FORWARD Data & Research

FORWARD collects critical data for researchers to study and analyze to better understand the experience of individuals with rheumatic diseases.

THE FORWARD COMPREHENSIVE QUESTIONNAIRE collects patient-reported disease and outcome data using validated measures. Diagnoses reported by patients are verified by physicians. The questionnaire is designed to provide a comprehensive, in-depth understanding of the patient's experience with their disease.

CUSTOMIZATION: Ask patients about what you want to know. FORWARD data covers a wide breadth of information related to the diagnosis and treatment of rheumatic diseases, comorbidities, side effects of treatments, and socio-economic measures. FORWARD can develop and include specific questions to meet your research needs.

FLEXIBILITY: Access to additional follow-up data. If your research project requires longitudinal data other than what is already available or additional follow-up with participants, FORWARD will assist you in continual tracking, analysis, and reporting necessary to answer your research question.


